

Description of Resources

- ❖ **Electronic Journals (A to Z)** - Alphabetical listing and access to all full text electronic journals available through the LECOM LRC. Coverage dates are provided.
- ❖ **DynaMed** - An evidence based reference with clinically organized summaries for nearly 2,000 topics.
- ❖ **EbscoHost** - Provides access to journal literature through several databases such as the Biomedical Reference Collection, Behavioral Sciences Collection and the Health Business Fulltext.
- ❖ **Embase (Drugs & Pharmacology)** - A pharmacological and biomedical database indexing drug information from 3,600 journals providing indexed citations and abstracts. This database has more international coverage than MEDLINE.
- ❖ **Evidence Based Medicine Reviews** - A resource in the Evidence Based Medicine Reviews combining six EBM resources in a single fully searchable database.
- ❖ **International Pharmaceutical Abstracts (IPA)** - Worldwide coverage of pharmaceutical science and health related literature.
- ❖ **Lexi-Comp (Drug Information)** - Provides quality drug information, keeping you abreast of the latest changes in the pharmaceutical and herbal marketplace.
- ❖ **Medline (Ovid)** - The National Library of Medicine's premier bibliographic database covering the fields of medicine, nursing, dentistry the health care system and the preclinical sciences. Contains bibliographic citations from more than 4,300 biomedical journals.
- ❖ **StatRef (Medical Texts)** - An electronic medical library enabling users to cross search 30 medical resources, such as *Harrison's Principles of Internal Medicine*, *Basic and Clinical Pharmacology* and *Current Medical Diagnosis and Treatment*.
- ❖ **UpToDate** - An online medical reference designed to answer questions at the point of care. Contains 8,000 topic reviews in 13 specialties.
